



To the Piedmont Park Area Residents and Businesses:

Live Nation is pleased to announce that Music Midtown will be returning to the Midtown neighborhood. Piedmont Park will serve as the host venue for the upcoming music festival, which will be held Saturday, September 16th and Sunday, September 17th, 2017.

We would like to inform you of a few details in an effort to minimize any inconvenience caused by Music Midtown.

- The official event hours are Saturday, September 16th from 12:00pm - 11:00pm, and Sunday, September 17th from 12:00pm - 10:00pm.
- There will be amplified sound during sound checks and performances. Sound checks begin Friday, September 15th from 5:00pm - 9:00PM, and again prior to performances on Saturday and Sunday, beginning at 9:00AM. The performances are expected to be from 12:00PM – 11:00PM on Saturday and 12:00PM - 10:00PM on Sunday.
- The following streets will be affected by lane or street closures during various times between September 8 - 21:
  - o 10th Street between Piedmont and Monroe
  - o Charles Allen Drive between 10th and 8th
- The following streets will be designated Resident Access Only on September 16th and 17th:
  - o Charles Allen Drive between 10th and 8th
  - o Taft Ave between 10th and 8th
  - o Argonne Ave between 10th and 8th
  - o Myrtle St between 10th and 8th
  - o 9th Street between Myrtle and Charles Allen Drive
  - o Park Drive west of Monroe
  - o Orme Circle west of Monroe
  - o Elmwood Dr. west of Monroe
  - o Cresthill Avenue west of Monroe
- Music Midtown will issue dash passes for your vehicles to allow quicker access into Resident Access Only streets.
- Dash passes may be obtained during the following times, location is TBD and will be updated and shared prior to the event:
  - o Thursday, September 14th from 12pm - 7pm
  - o Friday, September 15th from 12pm - 7pm
  - o Saturday, September 16th from 9am - 12pm
- If you are unable to obtain a dash pass and need to access a Resident Access Only street during the two event days:
  - o 1) identify yourself as a resident to the traffic officer at the barricade
  - o 2) present your ID with your residential address (and a utility bill if your address is not up to date on your ID) to the traffic officer
- Note: the dash passes DO NOT provide parking; they merely grant entry through police barricades. All standard parking laws still apply, and fines increase to \$75 for parking in a residential parking area without a city-issued residential parking permit during special events.
- You must provide proof of current local residency to obtain a dash pass, such as a valid license with your current local address, or a valid ID and a current utility bill or rental agreement matching the name on the ID.
- Should there be a large accumulation of attendee-related trash on your property after the event (keeping in mind most of the cleanup occurs overnight and in the morning), please call Whitten Waste Management to report the exact location of the debris: 770-439-7380.
- Music Midtown has received permission again to place portable toilets outside of the gated festival area in an effort to mitigate incidents of public urination. Public toilets will be placed in the following locations:
  - o Midtown and Arts Center MARTA Stations
  - o Monroe Drive near the Grady Stadium ticket booths
  - o Charles Allen Drive on the Grady High School side of the street
