### **Old Growth Forest in Morningside**

Our greenspaces are one of the most precious assets in our neighborhood. We are fortunate to count 16 different parks, greenspaces and nature preserves throughout the area, and now two of them, Daniel Johnson Nature Preserve / Herbert Taylor Park, are being inducted into the Old Growth Forest Network.

On **Tuesday, April 24 at 7:00 PM** at Emory's Math & Science Auditorium, Joan Maloof, PhD, founder of the Old Growth Forest Network, headlines a forum recognizing Atlanta's original woodlands. Besides naming Daniel Johnson Nature Preserve / Herbert Taylor Park as old growth, Dr. Maloof will take part in a forum, moderated by Maria Saporta, "Discovering Atlanta's Original Forests." Experts including Stephanie Stuckey Benfield, City of Atlanta Chief Resiliency Officer; Jacqueline Echols, PhD, Director, South River Watershed Alliance; Darryl Haddock, Director of Education, West Atlanta Watershed Alliance, and Professor John Wegner, Environmental Science, Emory University, will explore the vital contribution Atlanta's Urban Forests make to our city and ways to nurture their growth.

This free event includes a reception at which Dr. Maloof may sign some of her books which will be available. MLPA is one of the event partners. We hope to see many of our neighbors and friends there. <u>RSVP and learn</u> more here.





