8. Are your external entrance doors solid core and strong enough to withstand excessive force?		
9. Do your door frames fit snugly around your exterior doors?		
10. Are the strike plates and frames strong enough to withstand excessive force?		
11. Is there a wide-angle peep hole installed in your front and rear doors?		
12. If you have small child(ren) at home, have you installed a peep hole to accommodate their height?		
13. Are all exterior doors equipped with single-cylinder deadbolt locks with at least a 1 ½ to 2" throw? If uncertain, ask your crime prevention inspector for an evaluation		
14. Do you close and LOCK your garage door even if you are home?		
15. Do you LOCK the doors leading from the garage into your home?		
16. Do your basement doors have extra protection?		
17. Do your windows close properly, without excess play?		
18. Do you check to see if all windows are locked whenever you leave the house?		
19. Do you put a board or short wooden peg that snugly fits in the inside track of your sliding glass door?		

20. Do you have a pin in your sliding glass door?		
21. Have you done the same for your sliding glass windows?		
22. Do all your windows have proper locks on them?		
23. If you have louvered windows, are the panel epoxied in place?		
24. Have you walked around your house looking for "opportunities" that a burglar might use? Do you know what to look for; if not, get help from the crime prevention inspector.		
25. Do you keep shrubbery and trees trimmed back for a clear view preventing any one from hiding around your windows or doors.		
26. If you live in an apartment or other multi-family unit dwelling, do you make it a point to immediately report to management of any lighting or other security problems?		
27. When you observe a stranger in your neighborhood who is exhibiting suspicious behavior, do you call 911?
