

These LPR cameras, which are made by Flock Security, help the Atlanta Police Department (APD) track vehicles suspected of being involved in crimes from camera-to-camera across neighborhoods. Officers are able to view camera footage and get updates on vehicle locations in their patrol cars. Officers on patrol nearby to cameras where suspect vehicles are seen can stop the vehicles to investigate. For more information, see our [website](#).

**Where are you from originally?** Manchester, England


**Where did you go to school?** The University of the West Midlands (England)

## Alcohol License Permitting - ATAG Update

### Alcohol Technical Advisory Group III Recommendations

In conversations with restaurant and bar operators in the neighborhood, we know that the current system for alcohol licensing and renewals is very cumbersome and time consuming. From the perspective of the community, we have an excellent group of operators of these businesses, but there have been a few exceptions where enforcement has been a challenge. Elsewhere in the NPU and across the city, these issues have been extremely disruptive. Our NPU had two representatives appointed (from City Council District 6 and from the Atlanta Planning Advisory Board) to serve on a group to assess and make recommendations to improve the alcohol licensing system for the city.

The [referenced report](#) is the result of 19 meetings of the Atlanta Technical Advisory Group III (ATAG III) from March 2022 to June 2023. The ATAG III appointed body consisted of city citizens, each representing an indicated stakeholder group identified in the originating legislation 21-R-3040. After a thorough study of existing code, policy, and general practices associated with each part of the alcohol licensing cycle, ATAG III Recommendations address:

- modernizing Atlanta's alcohol licensing process to achieve greater efficiency and accuracy in application, renewal, and temporary licensing; improving access to public information for all stakeholders;
- maximizing existing resources and identifying new human capital and technological tools for greater efficacy;
- documenting and expanding policies of the Atlanta License Review Board; and
- strengthening enforcement of non-compliant operators.

*Establishments are not required to come before nor seek approval from neighborhood associations before they seek approval at the NPU. The NPU makes a recommendation on the application to the License Review Board (LRB), and then the LRB makes a recommendation to the Mayor (who has final say). Questions? 
