## **Club Platinum Hearing This Week - August 20**

On Tuesday this week, the next License Review Board Meeting will be held at the Atlanta City Hall. Club Platinum will be presenting their case to reopen. Please consider showing up for this meeting. A community presence can be quite impactful. Be forewarned, Platinum has cancelled at the last minute on July 23, 2024 and August 6, 2024. We will inform you ASAP if they cancel again. We usually know several hours beforehand and will send a blast email accordingly.

The last item on the agenda is KJBR, LLC d/b/a Club Platinum seeking to obtain a license "to operate a nightclub with liquor, beer, and wine consumed on the premises, along with customer dancing and adult entertainment, at 1905 Piedmont Road." This case will be heard as a due cause for denial of the application based on issues raised in the NPU recommendation for denial in 2022 and 2023.

# Directed Patrols - A New Service Offered by APD for Persons Who Are Traveling

As you probably already know, there has been an uptick in burglaries in Morningside this year. Since January 1, there have been a total of 14 burglaries in the neighborhood; 2 occurred at

apartments on Piedmont; one occurred at a club; and 11 occurred on interior streets. In comparison, there were three incidents in the interior by this time in 2023.

Because of the increase in the number of burglaries, the Morningside Lenox Park Association (MLPA) held a special security meeting by Zoom on July 9 to learn details about specific incidents and answer questions. About 70 neighbors joined, along with Council Member Alex Wan, Zone Commanders, and Officers from the Atlanta Police Department (APD) Burglary Unit.

During the call, Major Webster (Commander Zone 6) indicated that, given the history of burglaries in Morningside this year, Labor Day weekend may be the next time that burglaries might occur. As such, she suggested that residents could request APD directed patrols if they were planning to travel that weekend.

To sign up for this service, go to the new <u>APD online directed patrol request</u> tool. This site will ask for your:

- name
- home address
- email address
- phone number
- zone number (if you live south of Cheshire Bridge, your zone is 6; if you live north of Cheshire Bridge your zone is 2.)
- dates of travel

Then your information will be sent to the appropriate zone commander.

Of note, the vacation patrol services offered by an MLPA Security Plus membership guarantee a visit every day you are on vacation. In addition, the visit includes checking for and moving packages out of site, moving trashcans left in the street on pick-up days, and a daily email to the homeowner with a checklist of any completed activities. #### **Amsterdam Walk Correction**

Last month, we reported that Portman Holdings' applications for the rezoning and redevelopment of Amsterdam Walk needed to go before a quarterly Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP) hearing in September. **This is incorrect.** The <u>staff report</u> was heard at the second quarter public hearing on June 5 and does not need to go through the CDP process again. Apologies for any confusion.

At this point, both papers are being held by City Council's committees (Community Development Human Resources for the land use portion and Zoning for the rezoning). It is our understanding that Portman has not completed its negotiations with the Department of Watershed Management regarding the Evelyn Street easement. Without it, the project cannot proceed as this is one of the conditioned terms: *The project will have at least two points of vehicular access, one from Amsterdam Avenue and one from Evelyn Street.*

# Thanks to Infrastructure Bond, Park Improvements Begin Moving Atlanta Forward Vote in 2022 Shows in HTDJ Park

Recent park visitors have seen these improvements, but if you haven't yet, make plans now to take a walk in the park! As shown above, there is a new plaza to welcome visitors to the Johnson Road entrance, the site of the original Herbert Taylor park dedication in April,1987.

If you continue down the trail from Johnson Road, you will encounter stone steps (see below). These cross the drainage canal into the South Fork Peachtree Creek and serve the dual purpose of mitigating erosion and making the area accessible to hikers.



A new set of wooden stairs along Rock Creek eases passage around the neighboring private property.





At the top of the trail from Beech Valley Road near its intersection with Meadowdale, sets of stone stairs on the steep slope make entrance to this beautiful area safer, even when it's wet and covered with leaves.

Look for even more improvements over the next few months as work continues to make the park more inviting. Thanks to Atlanta voters for passing the bond and Councilman Wan for directing funds to parks.



#### **Great Southeast Pollinator Census - August 24**

The entire family can be "citizen scientists" for this project recording the activity of pollinators on one plant for 15 minutes. Organized by UGA the count documents year-to-year changes in the number of pollinators that are so important to Georgia's agriculture industry and our food supply.

You can learn more about the count on this <u>video</u> that will help prepare you for the census. Then join us on **Saturday**, **August 24th between 9:00-10:00 AM** when we'll have everything you need to do the count, including several plants that attract pollinators. We will even upload the results for you—what could be easier? Meet at the kiosk at 1343 Pasadena Ave NE.



# **Morningside Nature Preserve**


