Amsterdam Walk Follow Up


Portman Holdings' applications for the rezoning and redevelopment of Amsterdam Walk reached City Council's committees the first week of July (Community Development Human Resources for the land use portion and Zoning for the rezoning). At this point, both papers are being held.

The proposed land use change still needs to go before a quarterly Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP) hearing, the next of which won't be until September. The rezoning paper is predicated on the land use change, so that paper must also wait until after that hearing.

It is also our understanding that Portman has not completed its negotiations with the Department of Watershed Management regarding the Evelve Street easement. Without it, the project cannot or traterened management regarding the Everyth exect eacoment. Thirdurity the project carmet

proceed as this is one of the conditioned terms: *The project will have at least two points of vehicular access, one from Amsterdam Avenue and one from Evelyn Street.*


The purpose of the Subarea 6 Master Plan is:


- To build on the foundation of the 2011 Master Plan by documenting changes since adoption.

Senior Uitizen Anti-Displacement Grant

The Mayor's Office of Constituent Services has an important opportunity for our senior residents, the Senior Citizen Anti-Tax Displacement Grant. This grant is designed to provide financial assistance with property taxes for senior citizens that may be at risk of displacement due to tax liens, payment plans, or may have been turned down from other tax relief programs.

Key Details about the Senior Citizen Anti-Displacement Grant:

- Purpose: To prevent displacement of senior citizens from their homes.
- Eligibility: Seniors aged 65+, own and occupy a home in the City of Atlanta, and are delinquent on their property taxes.
- Application Period: March 2024-July 2024






Concert in the Park

Morningside Nature Preserve

We continue to be grateful to Trees Atlanta for their efforts to maintain and restore the Morningside Nature Preserve. On the third Saturday of each month, they host volunteers for Forest Restoration from 9:00am-12:00pm.



You can join them, as well, to promote a healthy plant community and a sustainable forest in the Morningside Nature Preserve. Your work will improve habitat for humans who use the greenspace for recreation and wildlife that call it home. Activities include hand-pulling and cutting invasive plants such as English ivy, Chinese privet, and kudzu in a densely wooded area off trail. Friends of Herbert Taylor and Daniel Johnson

If you've walked Rock Creek trail toward the confluence with South Fork Peachtree Creek, you probably noticed the progress made in June by our fabulous volunteers (including the super cute helper above!). Besides cleaning up some of the remaining Japanese chaff flower, they cleaned out an area between the trail and the creek, removing privet, invasive rose, amur honeysuckle, and ivy. In doing so, we spotted fern and muscadine—we will continue to look to see what else may sprout in the area.

In addition, most of the remaining mulch pile was distributed along worn areas of the trail. Thanks to Intown Georgia Native Plant Society (GNPS) Restoration Committee member, Jane Trentin, for the plant installation along Taylor Trail to the bridge. The shade loving grasses and ferns have replaced the English ivy and privet that volunteers recently removed (their dried remains form the trail border).

For the two upcoming workdays in July - **on Wednesday, July 24 and Saturday, August 10** - we will continue to remove invasive plants before they go to seed in the fall. Note that we will begin each session at **8:00am** so we can work while it's a bit cooler. Do wear long, protective clothing as poison ivy and pesky insects abound.

Meet at the kiosk (1343 Pasadena Av, Atlanta, 30306) and bring your family and friends—we have jobs for all ages and abilities. Working in the park for a few hours is a great way for students to get a jump start on service hours for the coming semester.

And we have a lot of fun! Come learn about the flora & fauna in the park. Experienced Friends of Herbert Taylor Park will be on hand to provide guidance. Bring your favorite gardening gloves and tools or borrow some of ours—and we have weed wrenches to use!



The market is open every Saturday morning year-round at Morningside Presbyterian Church's parking lot (1411 N. Morningside Drive NE). SNAP/EBT (food stamp) dollars are doubled for an equal amount of tokens for fruits and vegetables at the information tent.
